Nossa Senhora do Livramento:

A Catalogue of Coins from the Holy Well at Jawatte Cemetery, Colombo (Sri Lanka)

A newspaper article entitled “Holy Well among Jawatte graves” aroused my interest (Forbes 2002). It informed about the existence of a Holy well in the premises of the Jawatte Cemetery and the discovery of many coins within its recesses. According to the article, the Department of Archaeology in conjunction with the St. Peter’s College Archaeological Society had conducted excavations at this site which had unearthed this bounty.

As I am very interested in the Dutch period of the island, I then visited the Department of Archaeology and met with Mr. Nimal Perera, Assistant Director Excavations who very kindly introduced me to Dr. W. J. Wijeyapala, Commissioner General of Archaeology. I received more information about the well (Don Peter 1963, 1977) and I was shown the excavated coins. The entire find from the well was around 120 coins. I was able to recognize some of them as being of the VOC (Verenigde Oostindische Compagnie) period. It was an exciting moment, because it meant that this well together with its cache of coins had remained largely untouched for centuries.

I happily agreed to assist the Archaeological Department in archiving these coins. 115 coins were handed over to me and I managed to identify and date 112 coins¹. Three of them were unidentifiable. The list is annexed to this paper.

Whilst researching the periods of these coins – I made an interesting observation. All the coins were of the same circumference de-

spite them spanning the period from 1695 to 1923. From the Nagapatnam Duit, to the VOC Duits from the provinces of Holland, Zeeland, Utrecht and Gelderland from 1734 to 1786, to the English period coins – farthings and stuivers, halfpennies and one penny coins, to the Ceylon half cent, one cent and fraction coins of the rix dollar concluding with the Ceylon cent of 1923, the unique character of this collection was that they all had the same dimensions.

Not content to let this rest, I made enquiries in Holland if they could provide any insight into this interesting phenomenon but came up with nothing. I then contacted Dutch Historian – Ms. Deloraine Brohier and enquired if she had any information. Ms. Brohier then informed me that she had, in fact written to the newspaper informing them, that it was in fact, her father, who had found out, that the well in question was a “Fertility Well”. Women hoping to conceive children made the trek to the well and threw in a coin. That this ritual spanned such an extended period was indeed remarkable (Brohier 1984, 13 f.).

I then contacted Mr. Ashley de Vos, renowned architect, heritage conservation consultant and a member of the Numismatic Society.

Mr. De Vos threw some more light on the well, informing me that there existed two other similar wells located in Anuradhapura and that these were drinking water wells. All the wells had similar construction-steps leading down to the bed.

My own view is that people, who believed in the power of the waters of the well, drank from it and then threw a coin in. The legend must have passed down the ages because of the diverse nature of the type of coins within.

The well in question was supposed to have existed during the Portuguese period. However the fact was that only Dutch, English and Ceylonese coins were in the collection. Since the excavation had not proceeded to bed rock below water level, there is a possibility that there still may be Portuguese coins lying in the well.
