



Chiron: Editorial notes (2023)

General points:

- names of modern authors in small capitals (in the text body, notes and bibliography)
- quotation marks: «» or < >
- dash for page numbers and year dates: 1–3, 1991–1993
- footnote figure behind punctuation mark
- 1 space behind a punctuation mark; no space before a punctuation mark
- Greek words: common terms that are established in modern usage (e. g. koinon, demos, ktistes) are transcribed (but not italicized); all others are given in Greek.
- Please add an abstract and max. 5 key words.

Bibliographic points:

- full title is given of articles in journals and anthologies
- for journals: abbreviations of the [Année philologique](#)
- for editions and standard works of Greek epigraphy: [AIEGL list](#)
- place of publication not given; no italicization, no quotation marks
- authors' names in small capitals
- dash for multiple authors: SCHULER – ZIMMERMANN
- citations from research literature on two consecutive pages take the form “57 f.”; instead of “ff.” the exact page numbers should be stated
